### 2011-2012 SCHOOL PROFILE

#### SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY:

Brookland is located in the middle of Henrico County. It was built in 1958 on 33 acres. There are 13 buildings which include 7 classroom buildings, a gym and activities building, a library, three cafeterias, and an administration building. We are unique in our demographic cross-section of students.

#### ACADEMIC SCHOOL CHARACTERISTICS:

Brookland Middle School operates on a modified block schedule with a total of seven classes. On Mondays, students report to every class. On Tuesday through Friday, students have four classes per day with Tuesdays and Thursdays as odd days and Wednesdays and Fridays as even days. Our 1st period class repeats each day. The day begins at 8:25 AM and ends at 3:15 PM. Numerous instructional levels are offered in each academic course. Instructional levels include, but are not limited to, Exceptional Education, Gifted and Talented, and English as a Second Language. We have the largest ELL population in Henrico County. Students in 7th and 8th grades may begin taking courses for high school credit.

#### FACULTY AND STAFF:

For the 2011-12 school year, there are 70 teachers serving approximately 990 students. To better assist our diverse population, we are excited to have two Visiting International Faculty (VIF) this year. We also have several bilingual staff members. The administrative team consists of the principal, the associate principal, two assistant principals, and three administrative aides. The School Counseling Department consists of a registrar and four full time counselors, which includes the School Counseling Director.

There are two types of honor roll reports: **All A**, which requires a student to earn all course grades of "A" and **Honor Roll**, which requires a student to earn a "B" average in all courses taken. Honor roll reports are generated at the end of each marking period, each semester, and at the end of the year. Certain letter grades (D, F, U, WP, WF, S or P) exclude students from "Honor Roll" or "All A" reports. Letter grades of I or N are flagged for consideration at the school level.

#### FEEDER PATTERN:

Elementary - Students come to Brookland from Chamberlayne, Dumbar-ton, Holladay, Johnson, Longdale, and Trevvett. Attendance zone determines which students from these schools attend Brookland.

High School - Students will attend Hermitage High School or Tucker High School. Attendance zone determines which high school students will attend. In addition, they have the option to apply to any Henrico County Public Schools Specialty Center and/or Maggie L. Walker Governor's School.
