SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY:

Glen Allen High School is the newest high school in Henrico County. Centrally located, Glen Allen High School opened on September 7, 2010 and welcomed approximately 700 students in grades nine and ten. A grade level will be added each year until the four high school grade levels are represented. Like all students in Henrico County, Glen Allen students have the opportunity to attend one of the two technical centers.

The Center for Education and Human Development is also located at Glen Allen High School. This rigorous four-year program is designed for students who aspire to be educators or those who are interested in other leadership opportunities. The Glen Allen High School learning community is comprised of approximately 1100 students, 80 staff members, parents, and other involved community members.

ACADEMIC CHARACTERISTICS:

The school year is divided into two semesters. A semester is 18 weeks with two nine-week reporting periods. Seven classes meet every Monday and for 90 minutes on alternating days. The curriculum provides a variety of course offerings which include:

- **Honors:** English 9, 10, 11, World History & Geography I & II, 20th Century VA & U.S. History, AP U.S. History, AP European History, AP English II, AP Chemistry, AP Calculus AB, AP Environmental Science, AP Biology, PSC Geometry, Algebra II, Math Analysis & Trigonometry, Physics I, Biology, Chemistry, Spanish IV, Advanced Video & Media, Marching Band, Advanced Band, Specialty Center Information Technology Courses, Child Growth and Development
- **A variety of offerings** in Computer Science, Business, Family and Consumer Sciences, Technology Education, and Fine Arts
- **Dual Credit** opportunities are available at ECPI University, Virginia Commonwealth University, Hermitage and Highland Springs Technical Centers.
- Twenty-one block programs at the Technical Centers
- **Work Study Programs:** Co-Operative Work Experience for Special Needs Students and Marketing Co-Op

- **Exceptional Education:** LD, ED, HI, ASD, OHI, collaborative and self contained
- **Henrico County Specialty Center:** The Center for Education and Human Development

CLASS RANKING:

Class rank and G.P.A. (Grade Point Average) are determined by the levels of courses taken and the grades earned in those courses. Grades earned in courses prior to ninth grade that were awarded a high school credit will not be counted as part of the high school cumulative grade-point average. The initial class ranking is computed at the end of grade 11 by averaging the final averages of grades 9, 10, and 11. The final ranking is computed mid year of the 12th grade and is based on final averages of grades 9, 10, 11 and the first semester averages of grade 12.

Students who are earning either a Standard or an Advanced Studies Diploma are included in class rank. Students earning a Modified Standard Diploma or Special Diploma are
