## 2011-2012 SCHOOL PROFILE

### SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY:

Hermitage Technical Center, located in the western section of Henrico County, is one of two technical centers within the Henrico County Public School system. A student population of approximately 800 juniors and seniors from all nine county high schools is served by 30 faculty and staff, including 21 teachers.

### ACADEMIC CHARACTERISTICS:

Students who wish to attend Hermitage Technical Center are considered for admission based on a selection process. Students are enrolled in an academic program at their "home" high school while attending Hermitage Technical Center for their technical electives, either in the morning or afternoon. Classes are organized into three-hour blocks, and students earn three credits per year for course completion. These skill-based programs prepare students for life-long learning in the following areas: post-secondary education in a two or four year college or university, apprenticeships, military, career institutes; and/or the work force. Selected senior students are given the opportunity to work during the second semester in a job related to the classroom and lab experience provided by Hermitage Technical Center. In many of the Hermitage Technical Center programs, students are provided instruction in preparation for medical or industry-based certification or licensure exams. These exams are regulated by the Commonwealth of Virginia or accreditation/certification organizations.
