2011-2012 SCHOOL PROFILE

SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY:

Nestled off Nuckols Road and Concourse Boulevard, Holman Middle School opened its doors for the first time last school year. Holman Middle School is the newest middle school facility in Henrico County. Holman Middle was built on the property once owned and farmed by the Holman Family. The Holman's daughter still resides in the area and is very much a part of our school community.

Last year, our school earned the LEED (Leadership in Energy & Environmental Design) Silver designation. Holman Middle is equipped with high-performance and sustainable design strategies to provide an eco-friendly environment. The structure of Holman's design reduces environmental impact through areas including transportation, storm-water runoff, water use, energy use, acoustics, indoor quality, and the materials to build the school.

ACADEMIC SCHOOL CHARACTERISTICS:

Holman Middle School serves approximately 850 students in grades six through eight and utilizes a modified block schedule. Students attend all seven classes on Monday, and four classes on Tuesday through Friday. On Monday, each class is approximately 50 minutes. Tuesday through Friday, each class is approximately 90 minutes.

Holman Middle School offers a rigorous academic program, including a number of specialized programs to meet the needs of all students. Holman is equipped with state-of-the-art technology allowing our staff to use innovative techniques to promote lifelong learning. In partnership with parents and the community, Holman provides students with the skills and exploratory experiences to enable them to reach their maximum potential as independent thinkers.

FACULTY AND STAFF:

For the 2011-12 school year, there are 52 teachers serving approximately 850 students. The administrative team consists of the principal, associate principal, assistant principal, and three administrative aides. The school counseling department has three full-time school counselors and a registrar.

There are two types of honor roll reports: **All A**, which requires a student to earn all course grades of "A" and **Honor Roll**, which requires a student to earn a "B" average in all courses taken. Honor roll reports are generated at the end of each marking period, each semester, and at the end of the year. Certain letter grades (D, F, U, WP, WF, S or P) exclude students from "Honor Roll" or "All A" reports. Courses such as S.O.L. Enrichment, .25 middle school courses and Study Block are not figured into any honor roll calculation. Letter grades of I or N are flagged for consideration at the school level.
