2011-2012 SCHOOL PROFILE

SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY:

Hungary Creek Middle School opened on September 7, 2004 and currently has over 900 students. Located in Glen Allen, our school operates with one of the most up-to-date technology systems available. A state-of-the-art media retrieval system allows teachers to access video and DVD technology in their classrooms via an overhead beam system.

ACADEMIC SCHOOL CHARACTERISTICS:

Block scheduling allows teachers to provide in-depth coverage of content during classes that meet every other day for 90 minutes. To set the tone for the week, students go to all classes on Monday. The staff uses interactive teaching techniques to challenge and engage our students. It is our mission to identify the needs of the students and facilitate their learning by making connections between subject areas, maintaining discipline, and communicating effectively with parents and the community to empower students to become self-disciplined, responsible citizens in a global technological society.

FACULTY AND STAFF:

For the 2011-12 school year, the dedicated instructional staff serves approximately 900 students. The administrative team consists of the principal, associate principal, assistant principal, and three administrative aides. The School Counseling Department has three full-time counselors, one part time counselor, and a registrar. Our total staff exceeds 100 with over 65 teaching personnel.

Honor Roll:

There are two types of honor roll reports: **All A**, which requires a student to earn all course grades of "A" and **Honor Roll**, which requires a student to earn a "B" average in all courses taken. Honor roll reports are generated at the end of each marking period, each semester, and at the end of the year. Certain letter grades (D, F, U, WP, WF, S or P) exclude students from "Honor Roll" or "All A" reports. Courses such as S.O.L. Enrichment and .25 middle school courses are not figured into any honor roll calculation. Letter grades of I or N are flagged for consideration at the school level.
