

Henrico County Public Schools has adopted a new Gifted Plan. Here are some dates to remember.

October 1-31st: Screening window for 4th and 5th grade students.

January 1-31st: Screening window for K-3rd grade students.

How students enter the screening pool.

- * Pre-Screening Checklist of Gifted Characteristics completed by the classroom teacher
- * Inquiries from parent/guardian, professional educators, community members, etc..
- * Nationally Norm-Referenced Test Scores (96% or above)
- * Student Work Samples
- * Records of Identified Transfer Students

By October 15th or January 15th, letters will go home to parents if their child is being screened. This does not guarantee they will be referred for gifted. Any names submitted after October 31st or January 31st, will be screened in the next window.

November 1st or February 1st permission forms will go home if the student is moving into the referral process. Letters will also go home to parents whose child was screened, but at this time didn't have the pieces needed to move forward into the referral window.

November 1-15th: Referral window for 4th and 5th graders

February 1-15th: Referral window for K-3rd graders

*Students who have 96% or above on any nationally norm-referenced achievement or ability test will be an automatic school division referral.

November 15th or February 15th: Deadline for parent permission forms to be returned. The County has 60 school days to hold a meeting.
