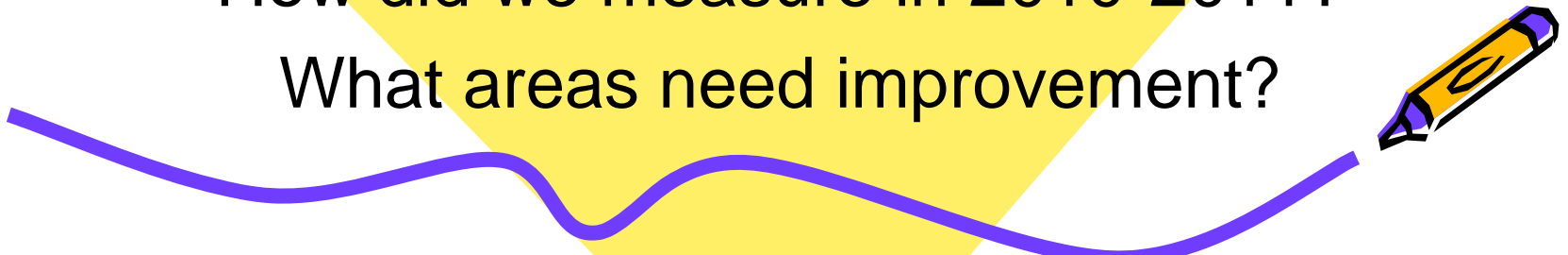




# Holman Middle School Parent/Student Survey Results

How did we measure in 2010-2011?

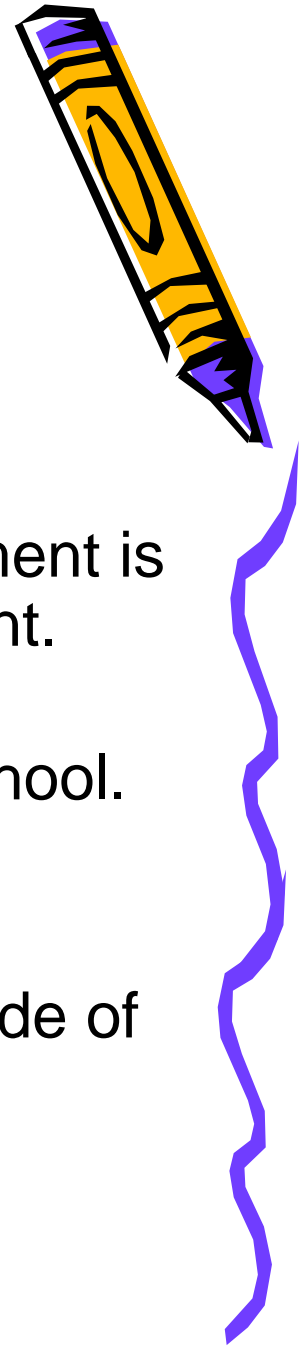
What areas need improvement?



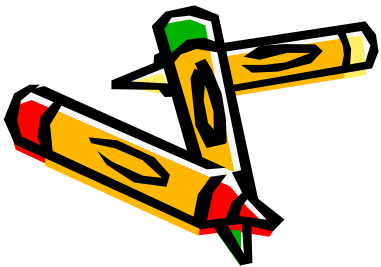

# Parent Survey

## Top 5 High Scoring Items



- 1. 100%: School facilities are well-maintained.
- 2. 99%: I believe that parental/guardian involvement is positively related to a child's achievement.
- 3. 99%: There is an active Parent Association (PTA, PTSA, PTO, etc.) at my child's school.
- 4. 99%: The school encourages students to be responsible.
- 5. 99%: My child has access to the internet outside of school.

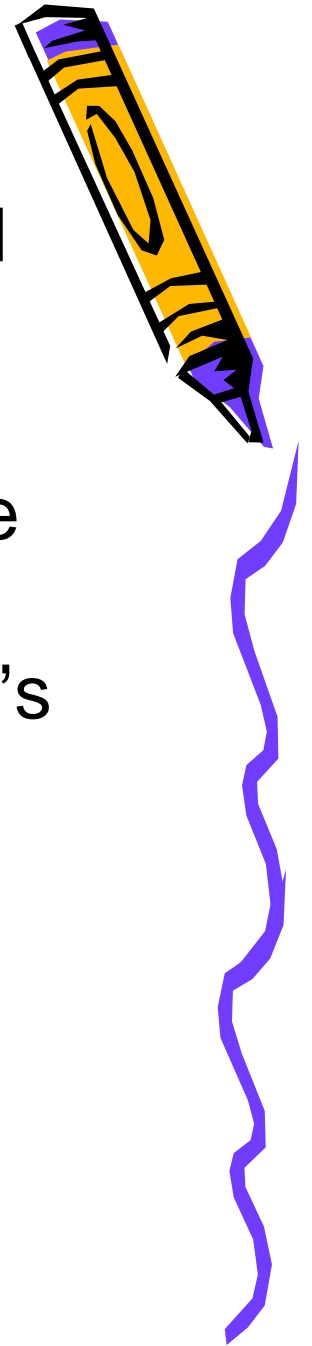


# Twelve Items Scored 98%

## Five Lowest Scoring Items

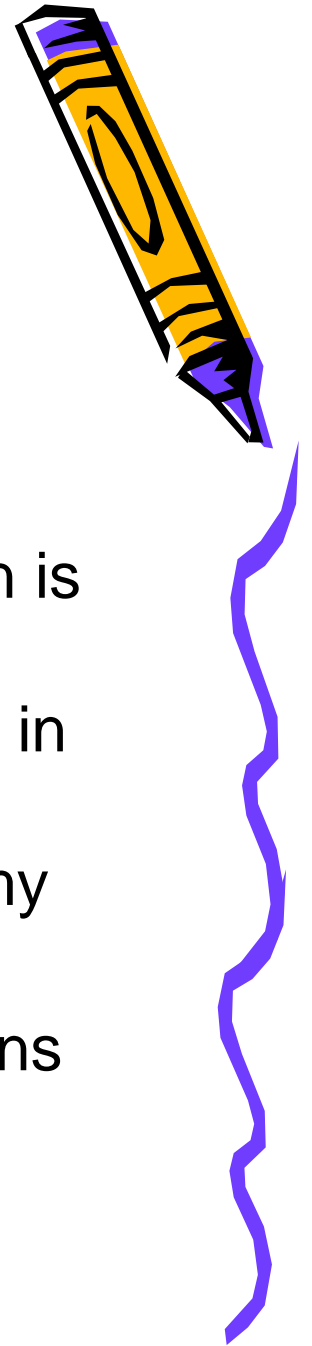
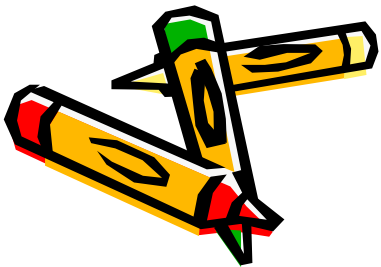
- 65%: I am satisfied with the quality of the school lunches.

## Top 5 High Scoring Items

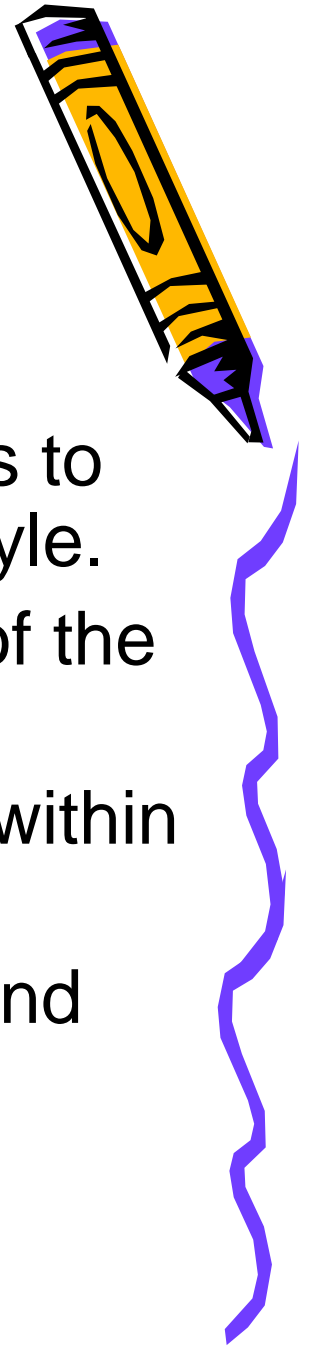
- 1. 98%: I know how I am supposed to behave while in school.
- 2. 98%: I understand that getting an education is important.
- 3. 95%: My teachers encourage me to do well in school.
- 4. 95%: My parents are well-informed about my academic progress.
- 5. 92%: I understand the academic expectations that the school has for me.

## Five Lowest Scoring Items

- 1. 31%: My teachers align their lessons to match my personal learning style.
- 2. 36%: I am satisfied with the quality of the school lunches.
- 3. 42%: Laptop repairs are completed within 24 hours.
- 4. 47%: My teachers seem to understand how I learn best.
- 5. 48%: I am very interested in my school work.



# Student Survey

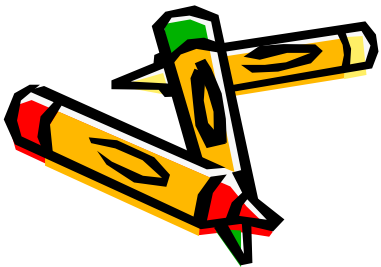
## Other Low Scoring Items
