

TRANSPORTATION

Our staff and drivers are committed to maintaining a safe transportation program! Riding the bus is a privilege and should not be abused. Students must ride the bus they have been assigned to ride. In order to ride a different bus, students must bring a note from a parent to the main office prior to the start of school day. The note should contain the **bus number** and **student's name they are riding with** as well as a **contact number for the parent**.

Students must have a letter on file in the office from a parent/guardian if they walk or ride a bicycle from school during the school year. Walking forms are available in the main office for pick up.

Appropriate behavior is expected on the bus. This guarantees the safety of all passengers. **The Code of Student Conduct applies from the time students leave their front door, at the bus stop, on the bus, at school, and the trip home in the afternoon.**
