## 2011-2012 SCHOOL PROFILE

### SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY:

We are located in the north central portion of Henrico County. Our school was built in 1951 on 20 acres. A major renovation was completed during the summer of 2002.

### ACADEMIC SCHOOL CHARACTERISTICS:

Moody Middle School enrolls students in grades six through eight in one of three academic programs. A large number of students are enrolled in the zone middle school program and they are given an opportunity to take advanced classes if appropriate. In addition to the zone program, a small number of students are enrolled in exceptional education classes. These classes have a small pupil to teacher ratio in order to assist those students with specific emotional or learning disabilities.

Moody Middle school also houses the International Baccalaureate Middle Years Programme. Students throughout the county apply to this program in the fall of their 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, or 7<sup>th</sup> grade year. If accepted, they are subject to the State of Virginia educational guidelines as well as those set forth by the International Baccalaureate Organization. This is a rigorous program, which requires that students possess a strong academic work ethic and be highly motivated. At the present time, 675 students are enrolled in this program in grades 6, 7, and 8.

### FACULTY AND STAFF:

For the 2011-2012 school year, there are 63 teachers serving 1015 students. The administration consists of the principal, an associate principal, and an assistant principal. The School Counseling Department has one director, two full-time counselors, and a part-time counselor.

There are two types of honor roll reports: **All A**, which requires a student to earn all course grades of "A" and **Honor Roll**, which requires a student to earn a "B" average in all courses taken. Honor roll reports are generated at the end of each marking period, each semester, and at the end of the year. Certain letter grades (D, F, U, WP, WF, S or P) exclude students from "Honor Roll" or "All A" reports. Courses such as S.O.L. Enrichment, .25 middle school courses and Study Block are not figured into any honor roll calculation. Letter grades of I or N are flagged for consideration at the school level.

### FEEDER PATTERN:

Elementary - Students come to Moody from Lakeside and Holladay Elementary schools. Attendance zone determines which students from these schools attend Moody. Students in the IB Program feed from 19 Henrico elementary schools. Rising 7<sup>th</sup> graders come to our IB Program from 6 middle schools in Henrico County.

High School - students will attend Henrico High School or Hermitage High School. Attendance zone determines which high school students will attend. In addition, they have the option to apply to any Henrico County Public Schools Specialty Center and/or Maggie L. Walker Governor's School.
